TIMBER PURCHASING AND PROCESSING POLICY

M H Southern is committed to protecting the environment through the implementation and maintenance of its Timber Purchasing and Processing Policy.

The Timber Purchasing and Processing Policy contains the following aims:

- 1. To only purchase timber that has been harvested in compliance with the country of origin's laws and regulations.
- 2. The company will not source any timber from:- species prohibited under Appendix I and II of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species (CITIES) illegally harvested or wood from genetically modified trees uncertified high conservation value old growth forests.
- 3. The company is committed to sourcing timber products from legal sources.
- 4. The company will promote the use of timber which comes from certified sources to customers and suppliers.
- 5. When purchasing timber to meet Customer chain of custody requirements then the company will only purchase from suppliers who are registered to a recognised scheme which is independently assessed by an accredited third party.
- 6. The company shall maintain registration to the Forest Stewardship Councils scheme (FSC®) and Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification schemes (PEFC™) and ensure the requirements of both schemes are fully implemented within the company's management requirements.
- 7. The company will ensure information provided to interested parties relating to the source of timber is accurate and not misleading.
- 8. The company will ensure that all employees associated with the Timber Purchasing and Processing Policy are given the appropriate education and training in Chain of Custody requirements.
- 9. Maintain timber off cuts and wastage to a minimum during the Processing of Material.
- 10. The Timber Purchasing and Processing Policy will be reviewed on an annual basis.
- 11. The purchasing policy is publicly available from the company's offices in Felling.
